purpose - to support caregivers who are feeling stuck, unsure of, or frustrated by the children's mental health care system

Goal - to increase the number of supports and resources for caregivers to navigate and access resources in the children's mental health care system

2024 focus area

Provide support to caregivers as certified Peer Support Specialists.

- Understanding the mental health system
- Interpersonal, relational skills
- Emotional support
- Navigation

Time Commitment

- Complete Peer Support Specialist certification training (paid for by PCLG)
- Act as a Peer Support Specialist inside children's mental health organizations in Hennepin County
- Quarterly PCLG meetings (90 minutes each) to connect, vision, and provide updates
